ELECTRONIC DATA INTERCHANGE (EDI)

NOTIFICATION TO WSOR

- A. All forwarding instructions must be submitted to the WSOR using electronic format (EDI). WSOR will provide its shippers a web based application for this purpose. Shippers may make arrangements directly with third party logistics services providers to submit forwarding instructions on their behalf via EDI. WSOR will accept forwarding instructions to its Customer Service Center via fax (1-414-438-8985), or via e-mail ([customerservice@wsorrailroad.com](mailto:customerservice@wsorrailroad.com)) subject to a \$75.00 charge per faxed or e-mailed Bill of Lading. WSOR reserves the right to reject as an unreasonable request for service, any "fax" or "e-mail" forwarding instructions that are illegible, whether due to poor transmission quality, poor or illegible handwriting, or otherwise. WSOR will not accept delivery of forwarding instructions by US Mail, express service, personal delivery, or otherwise. Forwarding instructions must be complete containing all required elements for shipment. This includes but is not limited to: Valid Origin Station, Shipper, Valid Destination Station, Consignee, Care of Party, Route (including junctions), Freight Bill Party (including full address of said party) and Method of Payment. Please refer to WSOR 8000-C Items 3000-3010 for charges related to Diversion and Reconsignment.
- B. Notwithstanding the foregoing, all empty release information must be submitted to WSOR using ShipperConnect™. WSOR will accept empty release information to its Customer Service Center via fax (1-414-438-8985) or via e-mail ([customerservice@wsorrailroad.com](mailto:customerservice@wsorrailroad.com)), subject to a \$75.00 charge per faxed or e-mailed release.
- C. When electronic or mechanical devices are used to furnish forwarding instructions and/or empty release information to WSOR, the recorded date and time that the instructions are received by WSOR will govern.
- D. Exclusions To The Transaction Fee: Shipper(s) who advises WSOR of a planned system outage forty eight (48) hours in advance of the outage will be exempt from charges for a period of up to twelve (12) hours starting from the beginning of the outage as notified by shipper. Shipper(s) must advise WSOR of a planned outage by sending an e-mail to ([customerservice@wsorrailroad.com](mailto:customerservice@wsorrailroad.com)).

If the Shipping Instructions application on [www.railconnect.com](http://www.railconnect.com) is unavailable for thirty (30) consecutive minutes or more, charges will not be assessed to shipper(s) who normally uses this application but is forced to use a manual method during the time of the outage.
